# 1. CALL TO ORDER, ROLL CALL, AND DECLARATION OF QUORUM

Chair Ricardo Diaz called this special meeting of the Urbana Civilian Police Review Board to order at 6:00 p.m. Chair Diaz stated that Tony Allegretti would not be able to attend. Diaz stated procedure would include public input, followed by closed session, decisions, and finally adjournment.

# 2. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Christopher Hansen welcomed Anthony Rice as a new voting member of the CPRB. Christopher shared some concerns in regards to the procedures of bringing forth documentation within the complaint process as well as the redaction process.

Emily Close share comments in regards to watching viral meetings as a whole. Emily requested that the Chair of the meeting announce and share all of the participants in the meeting prior to public participation, so participants know whom they are addressing. Ricardo Diaz announced all present participants and UPTV staff who were in attendance.

Scott Dossett provided follow up commentary to Mr. Christopher Hansen's procedural concerns.

3. MOTION TO GO INTO CLOSED SESSION FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONDUCTING AN APPEAL HEARING pursuant to 5 ILCS 120/2(c)(1) to consider and/or hear testimony on a complaint lodged against an employee of the public body or against legal counsel for the public body to determine its validity.

**4.** Scott Dossett made a motion to go into closed session for the purpose of conducting an appeal hearing on cases AP20-01, AP20-02, AP20-05, AP20-09, and AP20-18. Katrina Kindle seconded the motion. The motion carried by a roll call vote.

# 5. MOTION TO RECONVINING PUBLIC SESSION TO UNDERTAKE SUCH ACTION, IF ANY, AS THE BOARD DEEMS APPROPRIATE Chair Ricardo Diaz announced that there would not be an Appeals Hearing meeting on February 19, 2021 as previously scheduled. Chair Ricardo Diaz called for a motion to return to open session. Scott Dossett made the motion. Katrina Kindle seconded the motion. The motion carried by roll call vote.

Ricardo Diaz stated that board would be voting on appeal AP20-07 tonight and the other appeals listed on the agenda would be rescheduled for another date.

Chair Ricardo Diaz called for a motion to vote on case AP20-06. Scott Dossett made a motion on case AP20-06 that the Civilian Police Review Board sustain the findings of the UPD Police Chief. Darrell Price seconded the motion. The motion carried by roll call vote as follows: Diaz – yes; Dossett – Yes; Kindle – Yes; Price – Yes; Rice - Yes.

Scott Dossett made a motion on case AP20-04 that the Civilian Police Review Board sustain the findings of the UPD Police Chief. Darrell Price seconded the motion. The motion carried by roll call vote as follows: Diaz – Yes; Dossett – yes; Kindle – yes; Price – yes; Rice – yes.

Chair Ricardo Diaz called for a motion to vote on case AP20-17. Katrina Kindle made a motion on case AP20-17 that the Civilian Police Review Board sustain the findings of the UPD Police Chief. Scott Dossett seconded the motion. The motion did not carry by roll call vote as follows: Diaz – no; Dossett – no; Kindle – no; Price – yes; Rice – no.

City Administrator Carol Mitten made a Point of order: She shared that the CPRB voted down the sustainment of AP 20-17, however that the CPRB had not voted to sustain or remand, out of a total of 5 options.

Katrina Kindle amended her motion to NOT sustain the findings of the UPD Police Chief. Scott Dossett seconded the motion. The motion carried by roll call vote as follows: Diaz – yes; Dossett – yes; Kindle – yes; Price – No; Rice – yes.

### 8. ADJOURNMENT

Scott Dossett made a motion to adjourn. Scott Anthony Rice seconded the motion. The motion carried by a roll call vote.
